Did you know that human milk boosts your baby's natural defenses? Mother's milk actually helps babies fight colds, ear infections, and even diarrhea. Breastfeeding also reduces your baby's risk of diseases when they are adults, including diabetes, cancer,

asthma, and high cholesterol.

Breastfeed your baby for one year to give them a healthy start.

BREASTFEEDING IS BEST FOR AT LEAST EIGHT GOOD REASONS. IF NOT MORE!

- 1. Breast milk provides the perfect mix of vitamins, protein, and fat. And it is more easily digested than infant formula.
- 2. Breast-fed babies are more likely to gain the right amount of weight as they grow instead of becoming overweight.
- 3. Breastfed babies are at lower risk for Sudden Infant Death Syndrome or SIDS (also known as "crib death"). They have fewer cavities, and are less likely to need braces!
- 4. Breastfeeding also saves between \$2,000 and \$4,000 every year compared to the cost of formula! So breastfeeding is good for moms and dads too!

5. Breastfeeding helps mothers' bodies recover from childbirth faster. And helps them lose weight.



- 6. Breastfeeding helps protect moms from diseases like ovarian and breast cancer, as well as heart disease.
- **7.** Breastfeeding helps mothers bond with their baby. Holding a baby skin-to-skin and making eye contact helps your baby bond with you and feel safe.
- 8. Human milk also makes babies calm down and sleep better. This also benefits moms! In fact, mothers who breastfeed sleep an average of 45 minutes more every night than mothers who feed their babies formula.
